Election Integrity	HB 335	...the cancellation of a person's voter registration on notice that the person has acknowledged that the person is not a citizen; providing a civil penalty; creating a criminal offense.
Election Integrity	HB 4044	...a registrar's failure to cancel voter registrations under applicable law.
Election Integrity	HB 6	...election integrity and security, including by preventing fraud in the conduct of elections in this state; increasing criminal penalties; creating criminal offenses.
Election Integrity	HB 329	...election integrity.
Religious Freedom	HB 3940	...discrimination against or burdening certain constitutional rights of an applicant for or holder of a license to practice law in this state.

Election Integrity	HB 2546	...the enforcement by the secretary of state of certain voter roll maintenance provisions; creating a criminal offense.
Religious Freedom	HB 4500	...the protection of expressive rights of student organizations at public institutions of higher education.
Religious Freedom	HB 1291	...notice of the right to object to participation in an abortion procedure for health care personnel of a hospital or health care facility.
Ban Gender Modification	HB 2693	...the provision of and professional liability insurance coverage for gender transitioning or gender reassignment medical procedures and treatments for certain children.
Abolition of Abortion	HB 1515	...abortion, including abortions after detection of an unborn child's heartbeat; authorizing a private civil right of action.
Abolition of Abortion	HB 3641	...declaring void certain federal court decisions related to abortion and prohibiting cooperation with the enforcement of those decisions; creating a private cause of action; creating a criminal offense.
Monument Protection	HB 1079	...the relocation of the Battleship "Texas" after refurbishment.
