Ban Gender Modification	HB 4014	...the protection of children, including the definition of child abuse and the prosecution of the criminal offense of abandoning or endangering a child.
Constitutional Carry	HB 2900	...provisions governing the carrying of a firearm by a person who is not otherwise prohibited by state or federal law from possessing the firearm and to other provisions related to the carrying, possessing, transporting, or storing of a firearm;
Monument Protection	HB 2713	...the removal, relocation, alteration, or construction of certain monuments, memorials, or designations located on public property; authorizing a civil penalty.

Religious Freedom	HB 1218	...the display of the national motto in public schools and institutions of higher education.
Religious Freedom	HB 1569	...regulation by a property owners' association of certain religious displays.
Ban Gender Modification	HB 1399	...professional liability insurance coverage for and prohibitions on the provision to certain children of procedures and treatments for gender transitioning, gender reassignment, or gender dysphoria.
Constitutional Carry	HB 1927	...provisions governing the carrying of a firearm by a person who is 21 years of age or older and not otherwise prohibited by state or federal law from possessing the firearm and to other provisions related to the carrying, possessing, transporti
Constitutional Carry	HB 1911	...provisions governing the carrying of a handgun by certain unlicensed persons and to other provisions related to the carrying, possessing, transporting, or storing of a firearm; providing criminal penalties.
