Abolition of Abortion	HJR 80	...Proposing a constitutional amendment clarifying the Texas Constitution does not secure or protect the right to an abortion or require the expenditure of public money for an abortion.
Abolition of Abortion	HB 1515	...abortion, including abortions after detection of an unborn child's heartbeat; authorizing a private civil right of action.

Religious Freedom	HB 3940	...discrimination against or burdening certain constitutional rights of an applicant for or holder of a license to practice law in this state.
