Bills Filed

Constitutional Carry	HB 1238	...provisions governing the carrying of a firearm by a person who is not otherwise prohibited by state or federal law from possessing the firearm and to other provisions related to the carrying, possessing, transporting, or storing of a firearm.
Monument Protection	HB 3013	...displays and exhibits located on the grounds of the Alamo complex.
Monument Protection	HB 2866	...the preservation, maintenance, and restoration of the Alamo Cenotaph; granting the power of eminent domain.

Abolition of Abortion	HB 3641	...declaring void certain federal court decisions related to abortion and prohibiting cooperation with the enforcement of those decisions; creating a private cause of action; creating a criminal offense.
