Abolition of Abortion	SB 1671	...declaring void certain federal court decisions related to abortion and prohibiting cooperation with the enforcement of those decisions; creating a private cause of action; creating a criminal offense.
Abolition of Abortion	SJR 25	...Proposing a constitutional amendment guaranteeing the right to life of unborn children.

Monument Protection	SB 1416	...the removal, relocation, alteration, or construction of certain monuments, memorials, or designations located on public property; authorizing a civil penalty.
Ban Taxpayer Funded Lobbying	SB 10	...certain requirements applicable to political subdivisions and other entities that engage in lobbying and to the applicability of lobbyist registration requirements to a person who provides legal services to a political subdivision.
