Religious Freedom	SB 581	...regulation by a property owners' association of certain religious displays.
Religious Freedom	SB 654	...protecting the right to free exercise of religion and ensuring access to volunteer and faith-based chaplains and chaplaincy services for inmates.
School Choice for All	SB 1968	...the establishment of the Family Educational Relief Program and an insurance premium tax credit for contributions made for purposes of that program.
Ban Taxpayer Funded Lobbying	SB 10	...certain requirements applicable to political subdivisions and other entities that engage in lobbying and to the applicability of lobbyist registration requirements to a person who provides legal services to a political subdivision.

Election Integrity	SB 7	...election integrity and security, including by preventing fraud in the conduct of elections in this state; increasing criminal penalties; creating criminal offenses.
Religious Freedom	SB 29	...requiring public school students to compete in interscholastic athletic competitions based on sex and a study conducted by the University Interscholastic League on the effects of allowing a student to participate in an athletic competition des
Ban Gender Modification	SB 1646	...the definition of abuse of a child.
Abolition of Abortion	SB 8	...abortion, including abortions after detection of an unborn child's heartbeat; authorizing a private civil right of action.
Abolition of Abortion	SB 9	...prohibition of abortion; providing a civil penalty; creating a criminal offense.
Monument Protection	SB 1416	...the removal, relocation, alteration, or construction of certain monuments, memorials, or designations located on public property; authorizing a civil penalty.
